A world where people care about each other, their local environment, and the health of their area as a whole.



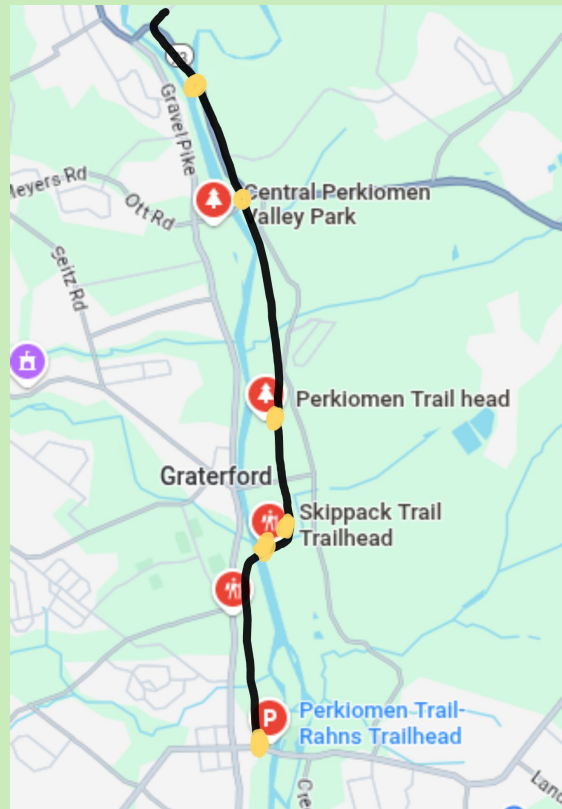
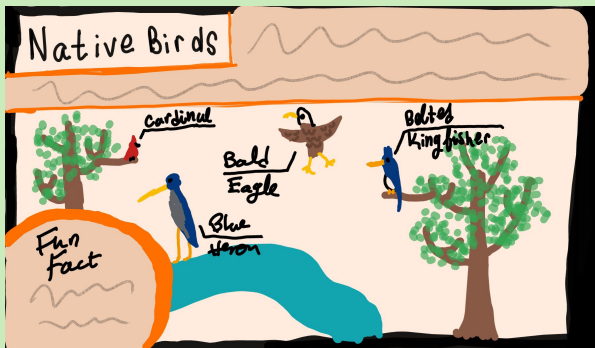

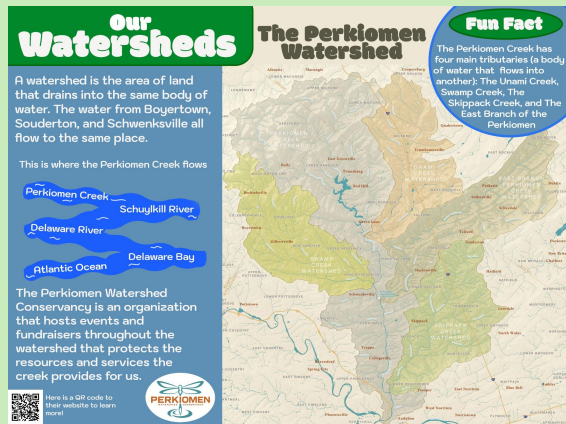
